



## Storyline Design Consulting

For the last twenty years Storyline Design has been working with teachers to assist them in learning about and implementing the Scottish Storyline method. We have developed a series of courses in response to the needs of teachers using the method, and we have worked with individual schools and school districts. Our courses offer graduate education credit from Portland State University. The Continuing Education office reports that our courses receive some of the highest ratings of all the courses they offer. Our goal is to provide inservice or professional development that is customized to meet the needs of individual teachers in specific situations.

### *Here is a list of some of the services we provide:*

- A series of classes including Storyline I and II, Storyline Studio, Storyline Revisted, and Storyline Alumni. (20 participant minimum)
- Individual consulting with teachers to include work on writing a topic, classroom demonstrations/ observations, and peer coaching.
- Professional development with school staffs to include curriculum alignment, writing topics involving multiple grade levels, and sessions on specific kinds of topics such as historical, book-based, and environmental.
- Classes offered in specific school districts tailored to specific curricular or grade level needs.
